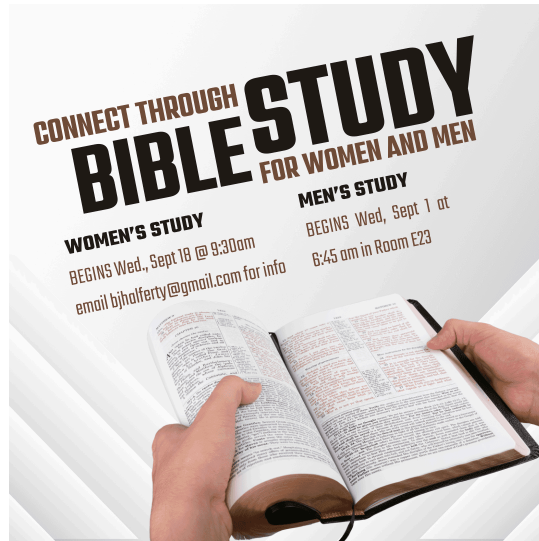

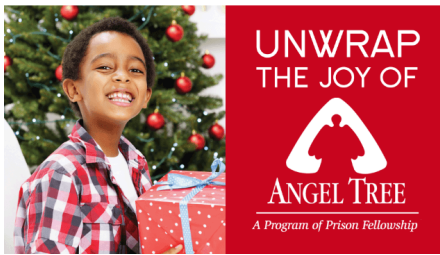
Women's Bible Study: Wednesdays @ 9:30am
